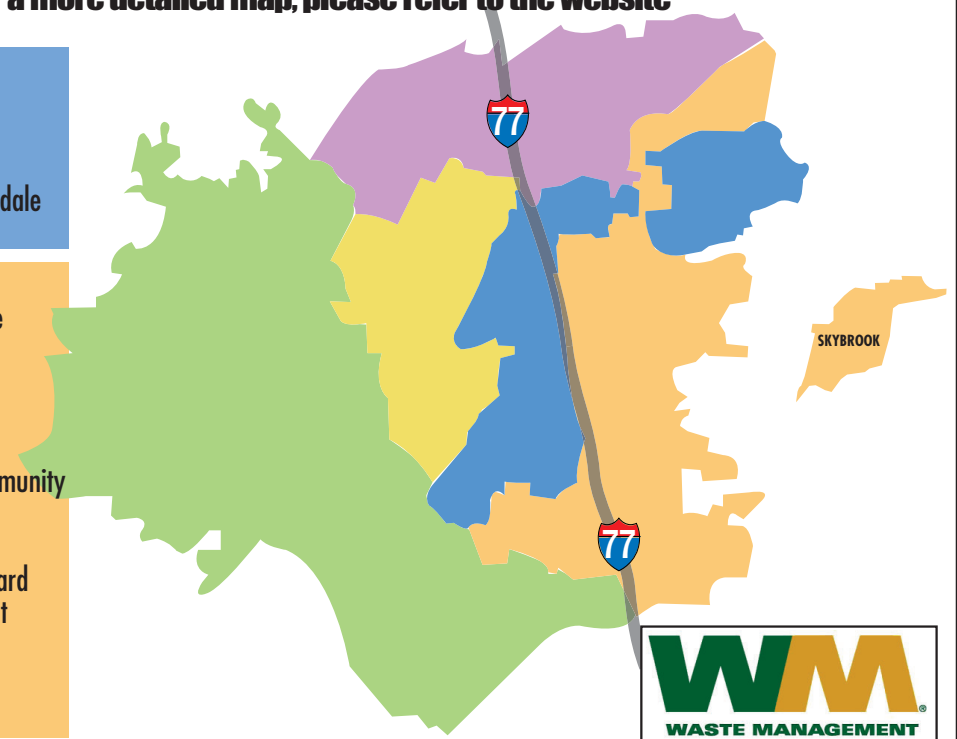

YARD WASTE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- No plastic bags, paper, etc. should be placed in the 96-gallon brown yard waste cart.
- Place limbs and brush 6 inches in diameter or less curbside, in piles no longer than 5 feet long, 4 feet deep and 4 feet tall
- Place grass clippings in 96-gallon brown yard waste cart. (Excess grass clippings may be placed in clear plastic bags outside of the cart)
- Place additional leaves and yard waste in clear 25-gallon plastic bags for pick-up. WM will pick-up up to 20 clear bags weekly.
- Please ask private landscaping contractors, such as tree trimming services and lawn maintenance, to remove yard waste generated by provider. (WM will not pick-up waste generated by these services.)
- Materials such as dirt, demolition debris, rock, brick, block, sod, water, and pavement are not considered acceptable for pick-up.

RECYCLING COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Please rinse and remove lids and caps for all Aluminum, HPDE #1 and #2 Plastics, Steel Cans, and Glass Bottles (green, clear, and brown).
- When recycling Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Phone Books, Junk Mail, and White Office Paper, place these in separate paper bag inside bin.
- Cardboard boxes must be broken down to 2 feet long, 3 feet deep, and 2 feet tall piles.

GENERAL RULES

- All items to be collected must be placed curbside by 7:00 am on your collection day.
- Leave at least 3 feet of space between items to be serviced.
- Place all items within 4 feet of the road.
- Do not place any items within 10 feet of your mailbox.
- Make sure all items are clear of trees and overhanging limbs.
- Make sure the wheels of your roll-out are away from the road (the lid hinge should be placed away from the road).
- Any extra materials that do not fit into the roll-out, should be placed in clear bags beside the roll-out.
