To assist the Huntersville Board of Commissioners in making appointments to the Planning Board, please respond briefly to the following questions. There are no right or wrong answers. Your responses will provide a framework for discussion with the Mayor and Commissioners.

Overview: The Planning Board consists of members appointed by the Mayor and Commissioners (for in-town residents) and by the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners (for ETJ residents). North Carolina law requires that the composition of the Board represent the relative population of the city limits and the extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ). Therefore, the Huntersville Planning Board consists of nine (9) in-town residents and at least two (2) ETJ residents and acts as an advisory body to the Board of Commissioners on all matters related to the growth and development of Huntersville. The Planning Board considers the facts relative to rezoning applications, new subdivisions and site plans, and ordinance amendments, among other issues. The Board formulates a recommendation on each matter, which in turn goes to the Commissioners for final action. The meetings take place at 7:00 p.m. in Town Hall on the fourth Tuesday of each month.
