## Sponsorship Opportunities

**Parking Garage Mural - \$25,000 - \$30,000** – Mural on either the side facing Highway 115 or the entrance side facing Gilead Road.

- I would hold off on this, if we do follow through with the new Town Hall, it would cover up the mural

**Arts and Cultural Center Mural - \$10,000** – Mural on side of the building facing Highway 115.

- Only murals on the panels in the windows, not on building

**Mosaic Benches - \$5,000** – Installed at bus stops in the Downtown area.

**Electric Box Mini-Mural/Wrap - \$2,500** – Small mural or wrap on existing traffic light electric boxes in downtown area.

- The ones by Town Hall?

**Sidewalk Landmark Mosaic - \$2,500** – Inlaid mosaic in existing sidewalk section referencing a former town landmark or historical fact about the area.

- Locations determined?

**Annual Local Artist Networking Event - \$500** – Annual event to encourage Huntersville resident artists to network and learn about current and future projects. Open to Huntersville resident artists only.

**Semi-Annual Huntersville Artist Spotlight Event - \$500** – Semi-Annual event to spotlight the work of Huntersville resident artists. Artists would display one piece and be on hand to talk to the community about their work and potentially take private commissions. Open to Huntersville resident artists and the community (Sponsorship price is per event).

- What is the money needed for?
  - Look at holding at a brewery or restaurant and people would purchase own drinks/food – sometimes the brewery will give the group a kickback of total sales
  - Possibly partner with Hunter House on these, they have the facility and resources for food/drink.
  - Shouldn't need any money for these
